

Dry Tortugas National Park Camping Checklist for Yankee Freedom Passengers

Be sure you don't forget any necessary items – there are no stores at the Park! Limited dry storage is available on the ferry so please pack your loose gear in water-resistant containers (like Rubbermaid™ 18 gallon Totes) as it may be splashed or rained on during the ferry ride.

- ✓ Tent
- ✓ Ground cover
- ✓ Mallet
- ✓ Cooler/coolers - recommend one for ice and one containing food & beverage iced
- ✓ Water- one gallon per person per day minimum
- ✓ Self-starting charcoal
- ✓ Matches/Lighter
- ✓ Grilling tools and cookware
- ✓ Sun screen
- ✓ Hat
- ✓ Towels
- ✓ Sleeping bags/cushions
- ✓ Blankets and/or sheets
- ✓ Foul weather gear
- ✓ Snorkel gear (unless using Yankee Freedom equipment)
- ✓ Antibacterial wipes (toilet paper is provided but there are no sinks)
- ✓ Camera
- ✓ Cash money – ten dollars per night per regular site, twenty dollars for group sites (more than two tents). The fee will be collected at the campsite. We also appreciate gratuities for the hard-working crew.
- ✓ Flashlight
- ✓ Lantern
- ✓ Batteries
- ✓ Environmentally friendly insect repellent (mosquitos are rare but other insects may find you attractive)
